With this filing, SWBT is proposing to restructure and add options to the Oklahoma 1+ Saver Direct plan in section 3 of F.C.C. 67 Interstate IntraLATA Message Telecommunications Services. In addition, SWBT proposes to offer a new Block of Time (BOT) plan called TOLL VALUE for Oklahoma. Customers that subscribe to both plans concurrently will receive a discount. Also, the TOLL VALUE Missouri Business Deluxe 2000 BOT additional usage charge will be increased due to an inadvertent error in transmittal 2954.

Supporting information discussed under Section 61.38 of the Commission's Rules, to the extent applicable, is included with this filing in the attached Description and Justification.
