With this filing, Verizon is proposing the following revisions to Residential Generic Calling Plans:

1. Local Package Basic is renamed to Verizon Regional Package and Local Package Plus is renamed to Verizon Regional Package Extra in Tariff FCC No. 4.
2. Local Package Basic is renamed to Verizon Regional Package in Tariff FCC No. 15. Additionally, the states of Florida, Idaho, Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, Ohio, Oregon, Texas and Wisconsin are added to the renamed plan.
3. Local Package Plus is renamed to Verizon Regional Package Extra in Tariff FCC No. 15. Additionally, the states of Florida, Idaho, Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, Ohio, Oregon, Texas and Wisconsin are added to the renamed plan.

4. Verizon Regional Package Unlimited, Local and Toll Package, and Verizon Unlimited Local Toll Plan are added as new Residential Generic Calling Plans in Tariff FCC No. 15.
