Application is hereby made by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) for Special Permission to waive Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules in order to withdraw Transmittal No. 3011 without becoming effective.

On October 25, 2004, SWBT issued Transmittal No. 3011 which proposed to change its existing one year Minimum Period for OC-48 and OC-192 OCN Point-to-Point Service to a 3 year Minimum Period. Existing customers were to be grandfathered, effective November 9, 2004, with no change to existing terms and conditions. Transmittal No. 3011 is scheduled to become effective on November 9, 2004.

With this application, SWBT requests permission to waive Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules in order to restore currently effective material and withdraw tariff material originally filed under Transmittal No. 3011 without becoming effective. SWBT wishes to withdraw Transmittal 3011 without becoming effective in order review issues identified in the proposed modifications.

A waiver of Section 61.58 is requested to permit the revision of tariff material to become effective on not less than 1 day's notice. A waiver of Section 61.59 is requested to permit revisions to tariff material that is not yet in effect.

This Application letter and the appropriate illustrative tariff pages are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).
