On October 25, 2004, SWBT issued Transmittal No. 3011 which proposed to change its existing one year Minimum Period for OC-48 and OC-192 OCN Point-to-Point Service to a 3 year Minimum Period. Existing customers were to be grandfathered, effective November 9, 2004, with no change to existing terms and conditions. Transmittal No. 3011 is scheduled to become effective on November 9, 2004.

With this filing, SWBT proposes to restore currently effective material and withdraw tariff material originally filed under Transmittal No. 3011 without becoming effective. SWBT wishes to withdraw Transmittal 3011 without becoming effective in order review issues identified in the proposed modifications.
