ERRATUM TO COMMENTS OF BIZTEL, INC.

BizTel, Inc., through its undersigned counsel, hereby submits the following errata to correct three inadvertent typographical errors in BizTel's March 4, 1996 comments in the above-captioned proceeding. Please associate the three corrections set forth below with BizTel's March 4, 1996 comments.

Erratum 1. The first *three* sentences of footnote 3 should be replaced with the following:

Contra, NPRM, e.g., at ¶ 7. BizTel *vigorously* disputes allegations in the NPRM, and in the accompanying separate statements by the two dissenting Commissioners, regarding supposed speculative actions or motives of incumbent 39 GHz applicants or licensees. See Partial Dissenting Statement of Chairman Hundt, at 2 & 5; see, also, Separate Dissenting Statement of Commissioner Susan Ness, at 2; contra, Separate Statement of Commissioner Andrew C. Barrett, at 1; Separate Statement of Commissioner Rachelle B. Chong, at 2.

Erratum 2. The second sentence after the in-line reference to footnote 43 on page 44 should be replaced with the following:

Based on its current assessment of the situation, BizTel believes that there is a real potential for interference to and from geographically adjacent co-channel licensee operations in both the 37 GHz and the 39 GHz bands.

Erratum 3. The heading and the third sentence of Section V(D) on page 45 (and the corresponding V(D) heading in the table of contents) should be replaced with the following:

D. If Any Government Use is Permitted In The 37 GHz Band, It Should Be Limited To One Channel Pair, Or the 37.0 - 37.1 GHz Portion of the Band

Should the Commission ultimately determine that proposed government use of 37 GHz spectrum is warranted, such use for any purposes should be limited to a total of 100 MHz, consisting of one channel pair or the 37.0 to 37.1 GHz portion of the band, and should be allowed on a shared basis only.
