

On Thursday, March 21, 1996, I and two other representatives of Commco, L.L.C. ("Commco"), Doane F. Kiechel and Thomas M. Ryan, met with Rudolfo Baca, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Quello.

We inquired as to the status of Commission action on Commco's pending Emergency Request for Stay and Petition for Reconsideration, both filed January 16, 1996, directed at the Commission's *Notice of Proposed Rulemaking and Order*, FCC 95-500, released December 15, 1995, in ET Docket 95-183 and PP Docket No. 95-183 (the "Order").

Commco's representatives reiterated the principal legal arguments regarding retroactive reach of the *Order* and discussed the financial impact on Commco and similarly-situated applicants of further delay in acting favorably on Commco's petitions.
