The information was submitted with a request for confidentiality, and a request that if confidential treatment were to be denied, the proffered information should be returned to undersigned counsel without consideration.

The proffered information was responsive to Wireless Bureau staff queries concerning the number of currently installed links, customers being served, breakdown of expenditures to date, numbers of offices, employees and independent contractors utilized and other information germane to the licensee's future operational plans.
