On June 10, 1997, undersigned counsel to BizTel, Inc. ("BizTel") held a telephone conversation with D'wana Speight, Chief Counsel to Chief of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. The subject matter of the discussion was a review of issues previously raised in the above-referenced proceeding that generally relate to the adoption of service rules and the accommodation of terrestrial fixed and satellite service spectrum requirements in bands between 30 GHz and about 50 GHz. BizTel's petition for reconsideration of the January 17, 1997 Memorandum Opinion and Order in the above-referenced proceeding was also discussed.<sup>1/</sup>
