
Dear Mr. Caton:

Pursuant to Section 1.1206(a)(2) of the Commission's rules, Teligent, L.L.C. ("Teligent") hereby submits this notice of an ex parte presentation. On July 17, representatives of Teligent met with Commission representatives to discuss the petitions for reconsideration filed in the above-referenced proceeding. Specifically, Teligent stated its position that there is no merit to DIRECTV's request for a spectrum allocation in the 24 GHz band and urged the Commission to consider other alternatives in addressing DIRECTV's spectrum needs. Specifically, the Commission was urged to consider allocation of alternative spectrum (not in the Digital Electronic Message Service band) or to require DIRECTV to coexist with the Digital Electronic Message Service licensees under specified conditions. Teligent was represented by Laurence E. Harris and by Antoinette Cook Bush of Skadden, Arps, Slate, Meagher & Flom LLP and Greg Simon of Simon Strategies, LLC. The Commission was represented by Chairman Reed E. Hundt and his Legal Advisor Tom Boasberg and Steve Sharkey of the International Bureau.
