Dear Mr. Caton:

Pursuant to Section 1.206(a)(2) of the Commission's rules, Teligent, L.L.C. ("Teligent") hereby submits this Notice of Ex Parte Presentation. On July 29, 1997, representatives of Teligent met with Commission representatives to discuss matters concerning the above-referenced proceedings.

Specifically, Teligent stated its position that there is no merit to WinStar's claim that a 99.7% availability rate would be acceptable for relocated DEMS facilities at the 24 GHz band or its contention that the Order in Docket 97-99 should be reconsidered in light of DIRECTV's proposals. Teligent noted that such a reliability rate would result in 26 hours of outages per year and therefore would not be commercially viable. Teligent also stated that there is no merit to DIRECTV's Petition for Rulemaking ("Petition") requesting a BSS spectrum allocation in the 24 GHz band. Teligent further indicated that it will file an opposition to DIRECTV's Petition containing numerous reasons why the Petition should be dismissed. It also indicated that if DIRECTV's Petition were granted, the Commission should (1) prohibit the location of BSS 24 GHz feeder links within a specified radius of any DEMS station, (2) cap the number of BSS

uplinks that could be deployed, and/or (3) require that BSS be secondary to DEMS in the 25.05-25.25 GHz band.

Teligent was represented by Laurence E. Harris, and by Antoinette Cook Bush and Jay L. Birnbaum of Skadden, Arps, Slate, Meagher & Flom L.L.P. The Commission was represented by Ruth Milkman, Karl A. Kensinger and Christopher Murphy, each of the International Bureau.
