To Whom it Concerns,


I am writing in favor to Petition for RM-9208, Petition for a Microstation Radio Broadcast Service. From information I have received on the internet, there is a growing need for low power community radio in small communities. From reading the petition, I feel it would be a great opportunity for private citizens to operate a low power radio station from there homes or whichever location they wish.

One thing I don't agree in the petition and I feel the FCC would also agree with me is the type of transmitters to be used. I will agree that a FCC certified device would be necessary to insure that it is tuned properly not to cause any harmful interference, such as harmonics, spurious RF, and unstable rf tuning.

A power level of 2 watts would be beneficial as well as the 1 Watt power level listed in the petition. Antenna height of 50 feet seems fair enough to cover a good area. People should have the flexibility of operating their station in either as a commercial or non-commercial outlet.

Again, please consider for Rule Making RM-9208, Petition for a Microstation Radio Broadcasting Service.
