Comments of John L. Ewy


I strongly support Low-Power Broadcasting for communities. I do feel though that you should consider AM broadcast along with FM broadcast. Listeners in small communities have suffered since large corporations have been allowed to own so many stations.

Our county has less than 2300 people. We deserve information and programming geared to us. For many broadcasters today, money is the bottom line, not the listener.

I know the FCC, feels that it doesn't have the budget to handle this important situation. I propose that you use Regional and Local Frequency Coordinators, in the Licensing Procedure, the same as is now done with Two Way Licensing.

I would be happy to come to Washington, to visit more about the need for Low Power Broadcasting. I will also let our Kansas Legislative people aware of this concern.
