As a broadcaster and senior citizen with 50 years of radio experience with NBC and ABC in Chicago, I am in full support of RM-9242 now before the FCC.


Rulemaking under RM-9242 would provide low power FM radio service to a limited area providing local community service not now covered by large conglomerates. In Chicago for example, one company owns 8 frequencies.

RM-9242 would provide low power community service not now available to senior citizens and other minorities. It would also allow those of us with limited funds and a lot of experience to meet the needs in a local area.

Legally authorized low power FM stations would be in compliance with all technical parameters to insure that they do not interfere with existing stations.

I would be interested in applying for a low power frequency if authorized by the FCC.
