I am sending this letter in regards in support of the creation of the LPFM Radio Service. Local ownership needs to be put back into radio broadcasting and to allow for those with limited financial means to own a radio station. This would benefit communities across the United States to have a voice on the airwaves and to allow the businesses of a community to have an affordable form of radio advertising. The large corporate owners of radio stations are mainly interested in monetary returns rather than a personal relationship to the communities that they are supposed to serve.

The local FM stations (upon passage of this proposal) would provide information on upcoming community events, school activities, and church functions. These stations could also provide programming, music and talkshows, which would be of interest to the community that the station serves. This form of radio would only be effective if the power limits are used as listed in RM-9242.
