

Petition RM-9242, requesting the creation of a Lower Power FM (LPFM) radio service nationwide adopting the powers levels listed in the petition is strongly urged. Creation of this new radio service serves the community interest not now seen with huge corporate stations. Currently access to the airwaves for individuals, groups and local advertisers is severely limited due to the current trend of large companies and public corporations acquiring huge numbers of stations at an alarming rate in many cases several within the same market.

RM-9242 will bring radio back to the community which will serve the public interest in ways the media is unable and unwilling to serve today. On this aspect alone I strongly urge the Commission to adopt petition RM-9242 right away.


