As a conscious U.S citizen, currently serving the U.S. Peace Corps in Morocco; I am concerned about the infringement of the 1996 Telecommunications Act on the rights of small, micro-based, low-power FM service stations in the states.

I am in support of Rodger Skinnern's, well-thought out, 25 pp petition to license Low-Power FM stations. I as well strongly and vehemently encourage the FCC to support "a true diversity of media voices" as well as eliminate market-entry barriers to entrepreneurs & small business wishing to broadcast in the states.
