

I applaud the FCC's decision to create low power FM radio service. This service is desperately needed in my community for the range of music, local reporting, political commentary, and other radio programming is severely limited.

To ensure that low power FM radio remains a source of diversity on the airwaves and that groups without significant financial resources will have access to the airwaves, I urge you to restrict the ownership of licenses to single entities, both locally and nationwide. In addition, ownership should also be restricted to locally owned entities and to small, low or non-profit organizations. Low power FM radio stations should be allowed to broadcast advertising, however, profit and revenue earning limits should be placed on the license holders.
