I would like to add my two cents, about "micro broadcast rule making" (MM Docket 99-25).

I see Micro radio as a betterment of the broadcasting industry, by providing a "proving ground" for new talent and new ideas. I feel the fears felt by big broadcasters is completely unfounded. I would like to submit the following for your consideration during the rule making process.

1. Keep sparsely populated areas in mind, many times micros will have to broadcast at the 1,000 watt limit.
2. Micro radio, should be kept in the hands of the "small people" as it is intended by the members of the micro radio movement.
3. A lower tier of penalties should be made because many times people in micro radio are just starting out.
4. Micro radio should be kept in the hands of local people.
5. Amnesty should be given for past broadcasters who would now be legitimate under new FCC micro broadcast rules.
6. Micro radio should be kept affordable, so the little guy won't be left out.

Anyway, I will be following the following rule making process with great interest, and hopefully will be filing for my own "micro licence as soon as they are available. I would appreciate being kept informed on this matter.
