
Dear Ms. Salas:

Yesterday, Joseph M. Sandri, Jr. and Barry J. Ohlson of WinStar Communications, Inc. ("WinStar"), and their attorneys, Stephen L. Goodman, Philip L. Verveer, Angie Kronenberg, and the undersigned, met with Thomas J. Sugrue, Kathleen O'Brien Ham, Josh Roland, and D'wana R. Terry of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau to discuss the status of the above-referenced proceedings.

In addition to discussing the status of these proceedings, WinStar requested, among other things, that the Commission protect terrestrial wireless operations in the 38.6-40.0 GHz band. In addition, WinStar reiterated its view that Section 224 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended by the Telecommunications Act of 1996, contemplates access by telecommunications carriers to utilities' rights-of-way.

As required by the Commission's rules, one copy of this letter is being filed in each of the above-referenced proceedings.
