

The honorable Congressman need not worry about interference to other broadcasters by a low power FM service since the FCC will probably limit the number of low power stations to those who are financially and technically qualified. And 1-10 watt stations cannot take business from the full power broadcast market.

Moreover the FCC must determine it's own effectiveness to enforce communication laws and regulate Radio Broadcasting.

Didn't Congress create the Federal Communications Commission for that purpose.

So I call upon the Commission to act independently--not politically.

And by so doing give the people a greater voice under the Law and Regulations of the FCC. Please approve the low power Fm service as there is a genuine need for a more informed public and the enhancement of public health and safety.
