

i would like to state my support for the fcc proposal docket 99-25 for licensing low power fm radio. as a citizen who has had an interest in low power fm radio i support this proposal and eagerly await the details of how to obtain a license. in regards to the requested comments i feel:

- i agree that most radio station service rules should not apply to low power fm stations.
- low power stations should not be allowed to be translator stations.
- revenue should be allowed to be generated by either advertising or underwriting. it should be up to the station.
- i do not feel that low power fm stations need to be non-commercial.
- i agree that the number of stations on entity can own should be limited to a small quantity (5 or 10 station nationwide).
- i think the application process should be a short-window on a first come, first serve basis.

i think that low power fm stations should be geared towards the average citizen and not the corporations. it should be easy obtain a legal license for a low power fm station. please help make this a reality!
