To the Secretary of the FCC:

I'm writing to the Commission to express my opposition to the proposal, to create low power F.M. Stations. I own Four Stations in Northwestern New Hampshire in a rural area of our state. We have 12 stations in our area broadcasting and selling advertising with a population under 100,000 people.

Adding low power F.M. stations doesn't make any sense. We have 10 different formats now which means our communities are being well served through a diversity of programming. Our group of stations spend many hours of our broadcast time helping local organizations and causes that directly benefit folks living in our area.

The biggest problem in adding new stations, even at low power, is signal interference. I am convinced that it will be a real mess over the airwaves. It's awfully tight now with the spacing. More signals will only complicate an already overcrowded market.

Low power F.M. stations will not benefit anyone either in programming or serving organizations, they will just offer another choice for an already overcrowded area with limited population base. In fact, our area probably has 4 stations more than is needed for the population we serve. Most businesses advertise on the radio here so a new low power F.M. station wouldn't attract any advertiser who couldn't afford radio advertising.
