

I ask that the commission give consideration to adding an LP10 class to the LPFM proposal. Such stations would provide good coverage for schools, neighborhood groups and individuals wishing to start a station because the intended audience is at a very close (less than .5 mile) range. I would certainly apply for such a permit and believe that many more would also.

I encourage the commission to require EAS compliance for the LP1000 stations. EAS for smaller operations is unnecessary since the coverage area is small.
