WE URGE YOU TO NOT CREATE ANY LOW POWER FM RADIO SERVICES, AS:

1. Low power FM will cause interference to existing stations. The band is already crowded and a new service on FM will lead to the same interference problems and quality degradation now experienced on the AM radio band.
2. Low power FM will harm the development of In-Band, On-Channel (IBOC) digital radio.
3. Low power FM will be an administrative nightmare for an already short staffed and overworked FCC.
4. Elimination of any of the current adjacency channel restrictions is a bad idea prone to interference.
5. Our station already suffers from a first adjacency station that should have never been located so close to us.
