

These are formal comments on the NPRM (99-25) regarding low-power radio:

1. The new low-power FM stations should be NON-COMMERCIAL.
2. The FCC should license only stations up to 100 watts.
3. Low-power stations should not be required to provide "2nd adjacent" or "3rd adjacent" channel protection.
4. Holders of station licenses should be required to live in the community served by the station. And no one should be able to own more than one station.
5. No sale or transfer of station licenses should be allowed.
6. At least 75% of programming on low-power stations should be local in origin.
7. In conflict over licensing a given frequency, find some way other than auctioning to the highest bidder.
8. No people who have engaged in civil disobedience by broadcasting without a license should be prohibited from participating, including holding licenses.
