

Having written a thesis on neighborhood radio some twenty years ago now, I applaud your efforts for creating a new class of low-power FM stations. I believe that the 1000 watt stations would be too large (offering needless competition with the current commercial broadcasters), that the 10 watt stations would be too small (why bother), and that the 100 watt stations would be just right. With a 3+ mile radius and the waived staff engineer requirement, I believe the option would afford a highly localized format for our high density metropolitan areas and could easily swing being supported as a non-profit community asset.
