

Although the June 1st deadline has past, I feel it is important for the FCC to know that this issue of permitting microradio stations is critically important to myself and a number of citizens. We strongly urge the FCC to protect and promote microradio stations.

Specifically,

- 1) By prohibiting the owners of large radio stations from owning microstations.
- 2) By permitting for profit microradio stations which are either locally owned or broadcasting local produced content.
- 3) Which permits microradio to broadcast in major metro areas, in wavelength not currently allocated.

Thank you for your consideration. The FCC's failure to grant microradio stations rights will likely result in it becoming a political issue pushed by local communities - I would strongly urge the FCC to get it right the first time and look like a hero, rather than supporting large corporate interests and trying to maintain the current concentration of broadcasting power (which would make the FCC look like a pawn).
