Comments of Steve Stemmerman

I'm writing as a volunteer of a former unlicensed low power community access station in Lawrence, Kansas (KAW 88.9 FM). We operated from a downtown location 12 hours a day, 7 days a week, for 15 months. We were, at any given time, over 85 volunteers, doing over 65 individually created programs. Guests were encouraged, with over 1000 Lawrence residents sharing their thoughts and interests behind our microphone. As people of all backgrounds participated, our station became a direct representation of the creativity and diversity of our city.

We voluntarily disbanded after our frequency was assigned to a translator broadcasting the signal of a Christian satellite network from Twin Falls, Idaho. Without a station to promote NPRM letter writing, and since many Lawrence residents had already written letters in response to our first FCC notification, our wavier request, and the last public comment period, we decided to submit our petition as proof of the value and support a low power community access station can generate, rather than solicit individual letters.

The intent of the NPRM is good, but much of the details do not seem to be viable for local community access, and it is to these points that I would like to reply to.

The overriding issue seems to be spacing. Where will LPFM stations fit in ? The current emphasis seems to be with the larger stations.(primary status for LP 1000 stations, secondary status otherwise). Harold Furchtgott-Roth is quite correct in his assertion that few new LP 1000 stations could be added to the dial. The likelihood of finding space for smaller stations is much greater. Please give communities the power to do as much as they can with what they have available. Some 2nd adjacent channels may work some may not, depending on the proximity and the wattage levels of the stations involved. If a station can fit, regardless of the channel spacing or wattage level, and not cause interference, then why should a community not be allowed to provide a valuable service by broadcasting to their own community ? Directional antennas and side ban filters can go a long ways in creating a stable non-interfering signal.

Forget the notion of auctions or lotteries. Preference should be given to those willing to provide the broadest public access, with no restrictions as to how they are financed. Only the LP 1000 stations will have enough range to consider profitability. LP 100 stations should be able to finance themselves in whatever way works best for their particular community. Our station was financed by donation cans in local businesses where customers could toss in their change. Many of these businesses also signed on for sponsorships for 35 dollars a month for eight announcements a week. Providing access for small businesses, most of whom were too small to be approached by commercial advertisers, was one more example of our many forms of community service. Non-profit organizations were always given announcements for free.

We in Lawrence have witnessed the value of a low power community station, and watched in amazement as people from all backgrounds came together to participate in it's development. Community radio celebrates and enhances the local culture from which it originates. LPFM can make this opportunity available to ALL communities. Secondary status for LP100 stations would be a grave disservice These stations are very much needed and their viability must be protected.

Re: MM Docket 99-25

Since the passage of the Telecommunications act of 1996, local ownership of radio stations has almost vanished, with the possibility of locally acquiring a station now almost impossible. Low power FM can provide a means of allowing communities an opportunity to support and enhance a local culture in a vastly homogenizing world - an avenue for people of all backgrounds to come together to appeal to the specific interests of their community. With an often overcrowded dial, low power stations may be the only viable way that space for such stations can now be created. The service that could be generated by small community stations is unlimited. The denial of access to such stations is a loss too great to consider.

We strongly support the intent of rule change proposal docket 99-25 in creating community opportunities on the public's airwaves. We do take issue with current considerations such as categorizing low power as a secondary service. A secondary service radio station could be bumped by any larger first class station wanting the space. This isn't viable community access. Low power stations need the flexibility to best meet their community needs, all wattage levels under 100 watts need to be considered. Preference must be given to stations providing community access, rather than being sold through auctions to the highest bidder, or allocated through lotteries. Local access stations must also be given priority over translators carrying out of state signals.

Community radio is the public interest. We ask you to make your decisions wisely.
