

I would like to propose that there be a reserved frequency for police for use at the scene of traffic accidents on highways.

Such a use could reduce traffic congestion related to highway accidents. As commuters hit a backup, they switch to the reserved frequency and hear:

- a)how many lanes / which lanes are involved,
- b)expected time until clearing, and
- c)proposed alternative routes.

Such a system provides improved traffic flow, universal access to the information and at little cost.
