Dear Ms. Salas:

This statement is filed on behalf of The George Washington University, Washington, D.C. to report on a meeting held on July 21, 1999 between the President of the University and members of his staff (Senior Counsel Charles Barber and Director of the School of Media and Public Affairs Jean Folkerts) with Chairman William E. Kennard and member of his staff. At that meeting, the University's representatives elaborated on some of the positions set forth in its Comments in the above-referenced proceeding.

The subjects of the discussion included the need for a low power FM service, the need for insuring that the service will in fact result in diversity of views, methods for assigning such stations, the need for a showing by applicants of financial ability to operate, and reservation of licenses in the new service for noncommercial applicants. The history of the University's efforts to acquire a radio station, its need for such an outlet, and its ability to serve significant listening groups within the range of a low power station were also discussed.
