FCC:

I am very happy you folks are finally responding to the will of the people to communicate without restrictions imposed by government and industry. In order to maintain the integrity of micropower radio, I strongly urge you to incorporate the following principles in micropower radio licensing:

- ① Micropower radio licenses must be reserved for NON-PROFIT, NON-COMMERCIAL operators. Allowing commercial broadcasters access to micropower radio license will not improve the current state of radio!
- ② Micropower radio licenses must include a requirement for local origination of programming. Micropower radio is about local, community news and information. Allowing nationwide networks of micropower stations will not improve the current state of radio!

The FCC has a duty to encourage the democratization of the airwaves and the blossoming of free speech. Presently, free speech is only available to the RICH!
