

Dear Commissioner, I am a big supporter of LPFM Class creation. I reside in Pasadena, California, which is the home of more than 18,000 Armenian immigrants like myself. I do wish to establish a LPFM station in my town to reach the members of my community in their own language. Members of minority groups are not represented by large radio stations because such stations are profit driven and care about their shareholders rather than the community they serve. LPFM stations should be allowed to advertise to generate the funds needed to pay for operating expenses. Also LPFM stations should not be forced to operate 24hrs/day because most of the tasks will be performed by volunteers. I personally like to obtain a LPFM station license for my town. LPFM stations should be allowed to be owned by individuals and organizations and their number should not be limited to one per town or locality. LPFM stations should not be forced to buy expensive equipment but all equipment used should meet FCC requirements.
