I am writing in regards to the proposal to license new 1000 watt and 100 watt low power FM radio stations. I am a freelance film editor, living in Los Angeles, and an avid radio listener and taper. I often bemoan the lack of variety and originality on the airwaves here in Southern California. Nearly every station seems geared to the lowest common denominator, and to find truly groundbreaking broadcasting one must tune in during the wee hours of the morning. If a greater variety of stations were allowed on the air- especially small ones, with low overhead- I believe that a greater variety of interests could be addressed. Corporate run radio nearly always lacks a personal touch, where the on-air person is allowed free reign. I believe that if CPM stations are available, the public will have access to a far greater range of on air topics, musical choices, and points of view. I would welcome the stimulating atmosphere this would provide.
