

I am for the Low-Power Radio Service Proposal. The current situation with the large corporations having bought the vast majority of commercial stations, does not serve the public interest, just the corporate bottom line. Regarding the proposal, I would limit ownership of the new low power stations to 1 per applicant. Further, I would exempt existing commercial AM & FM licensees from being eligible for a low power license. For those "pirate broadcasters", I would have the FCC grant them a conditional license, but only if their past "pirate" activity ceased promptly, after FCC notification.
