
Dear Mr. Kennard:

As President of a city activist organization, Advocates For A Better Community, we are very interested in implementing community communications free from the commercial interests. These have historically monopolized local media. We have no local radio station and Morro Bay's only newspaper is forced to favor the business interests of it's advertisers over residents.

A few years ago ABC wrote and circulated a voter initiative measure that would have given the people un-biased community cable TV (peg) programing. However business interests successfully fought and defeated the measure at the polls, leaving us without any true community communication media.

Our thirty year old group is very interested in low power FM broadcasting and encourage the FCC to license it. This is our only alternative to expensive legal battles.
