
Good Morning:

This is a letter in response to the proposal currently before the Commission to establish new classes of "low power" FM stations.

These new stations can only be established by relaxing the restrictions on co-channel and adjacent channel interference. The resulting chaos will mortally damage the viability of small-town radio. This interference will also doom implementation of an IBOC system in small markets such as those served by our stations.

The FCC cannot repeal the laws of physics. All of our stations are little Class A FM's. As small-market broadcasters we are doing the best we can within our already severely limited coverage area to provide local news and public services. The interference caused by the current LPFM proposal will without a doubt destroy our coverage of the communities we are pledged to serve.
