
Mr. Kennard:

In reference to the proposed rulemaking on Low-Power FM:

- (1) Low-Power Stations are sure to cause interference to existing FM Stations.
- (2) Many existing FM Stations are already in poor financial shape and will suffer due to increased competition for advertising dollars.
- (3) The Commission cannot efficiently enforce the Rules and Regulations on that many more Broadcasters, so the Broadcast Band will no doubt fall to the same fate as C.B. Radio.

I urge the Commission not to proceed with the Low-Power Rulemaking on FM. There are plenty of AM Stations that can be purchased if someone wants to become a Broadcaster.
