

I do support the creation of low power FM radio service. LPFM will be a great communication tool for many individuals, communities, minority ethnic groups and organizations.

I kindly request the Commission to consider the following suggestions in adopting it's Proposed Rule regarding LPFM in Docket 99-25:

- 1- LPFM stations should be allowed to sell advertising time.
- 2- LPFM stations should be allowed to have flexible operating hours.
- 3- LPFM stations should be allowed to broadcast in stereo or mono.
- 4- LPFM stations should be allowed to be owned by any type of legal entity; for-profit or non-profit.
- 5- 2nd & 3rd adjacent channel restrictions should not be considered for LP10 & LP100 stations because of their low powers.
- 6- the Commission should use a special Interference Prediction method and not it's "strict mileage seperation" tables or else, many large cities will not have any LPFM stations.

CONCLUSION:I strongly urge the Commission to adopt its Proposed Rule and make the long waited LPFM service a reality at the steps of the new millanum.
