My name is Vasken Samuelian; I am a professional DJ with over 15 years of experience. I support the creation of low power FM radio service. I am a member of an ethnic minority group residing in Pasadena California. If LPFM becomes reality, I along with several other members of my community will volunteer our times to establish and operate an LP100 FM station with an ethnic format.

I urge the Commission to adopt its Proposed Rule regarding LPFM and kindly request the Commission to allow LPFM stations to broadcast commercials and generate the needed funds for operating expenses.

I also urge the Commission to incorporate changes to its Proposed Rule and ease its methods of predicting interference for LPFM stations. Many large metropolitan areas like where I reside will not have the chance of having an LP100 or LP1000 station if the Commission continues to use its strict mileage separation tables.

I also urge the Commission to drop its 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> adjacent channel restrictions for LPFM station.
