Representatives of the Alliance for Community Media met on October 26<sup>th</sup>, 1999 with Thomas Power, Senior Advisor to Chairman William Kennard to discuss many concerns of the members of the Alliance for Community Media who are concerned with Public, Educational and Governmental (PEG) Access television. Representing the Alliance for Community Media were Bunnie Riedel, Margaret Juliano, and Jim Horwood. In discussing these concerns Ms. Riedel and Mr. Power discussed the implementation of low power radio stations, how licenses would be awarded, and the role that PEG centers could play in providing an infrastructure for training.

The discussion primarily concerned the convergence of telecommunications technology and how current regulations will affect the development of new technology as well as general information about the interests and concerns of PEG centers.
