United States Code

TITLE 15 - COMMERCE AND TRADE
CHAPTER 1 - MONOPOLIES AND COMBINATIONS IN RESTRAINT
OF TRADE

SECTION 1 Every contract, combination in the form of trust or otherwise,
or
conspiracy, in restraint of trade or commerce
among the several States, or with foreign nations, is declared to be
illegal. Every person who shall make any contract or engage
in any combination or conspiracy hereby declared to be illegal shall be
deemed guilty of a felony, and, on conviction thereof,
shall be punished by fine not exceeding ten million dollars if a
corporation, or, if any other person, three hundred and fifty
thousand dollars, or by imprisonment not exceeding three years, or by
both
said punishments, in the discretion of the court.

SECTION 2 Every person who shall monopolize, or attempt to monopolize,
or
combine or conspire with any other person or
persons, to monopolize any part of the trade or commerce among the

several

States, or with foreign nations, shall be deemed
guilty of a felony, and, on conviction thereof, shall be punished by
fine

not exceeding ten million dollars if a corporation, or, if
any other person, three hundred and fifty thousand dollars or by
imprisonment not exceeding three years, or by both said
punishments, in the discretion of the court.
