On November 2, 1999, representatives of Teledesic LLC attended a meeting with Don Abelson, Steve Selwyn, Rick Engelman, and Ed Jacobs of the International Bureau. Suzanne Hutchings, Wayne Longman, and I attended on behalf of Teledesic. We discussed the broad range of matters addressed in the above-captioned rulemaking, focusing in particular on the need to designate a full 500 MHz for NGSO FSS downlinks and the need to adopt an economically efficient measure of the compensation obligation to the extent that incumbent users must be relocated. The substantive points have all been covered in comments that Teledesic has filed previously with the Commission.
