Dear Ms. Salas:

On Wednesday, February 2, 2000, John Hane, Senior Vice President of Pegasus Development Corporation ("Pegasus"), John Kiesling, Pegasus' consulting engineer, and Stephen Berman, counsel for Pegasus, met with Edward Jacobs, Karl Kensinger, and Steve Selwyn of the International Bureau to discuss issues that Pegasus has addressed in its filings in the above-captioned proceeding. Pegasus' representatives also addressed the prospective allocation of a greater amount of co-primary downlink FS/FSS spectrum than previously proposed by the Commission, and described the potential effects of such an allocation plan on Pegasus' proposed broadband FSS system. On Thursday, February 3, 2000, Stephen Berman discussed these issues further with Steve Selwyn in a telephone conversation, focusing on the respective rights of FS and FSS operators in co-primary FS/FSS spectrum.
