

To the Commission:

Because of the position of the National Association of Broadcasters with respect to this proceeding (MM 99-25) in Congress, please make this Electronic Comment Filing System message my categorical informal objection to the grant of renewal of any license or extension of any instrument of authorization of any broadcast station which is member of the National Association of Broadcasters. It would seem that such member stations -- by virtue of their membership in NAB -- would reflect the following: an unwillingness to yield to public will, a vindictive spirit toward the free exercise of speech and press by citizens of the United States of America, and a contempt for the authority of the Federal Communications Commission. For these reasons, I am obliged to conclude that any station which was a NAB member would have to overcome the strong presumption that its continued right to operate was not in the public interest, convenience, and necessity. For these reasons, I urge the FCC that this document is to be entered in each and every future license renewal or authorization extension proceeding involving a licensee or permittee that is a member of NAB.
