
Re: Low Frequency Radio Stations

I have been reading about your plan to provide citizens with low frequency radio communications.

The idea has tremendous merit, allows small groups and organizations to get out messages in a local area where the information would be of a limited nature and information which would get lost in commercial radio broadcasting even if it were affordable otherwise.

It is strongly urged that you do proceed with the permits, giving a great deal of consideration to areas where radio transmissions are generally not well received, such as small towns, indian reservations in isolated desert areas, mountainous areas, etc., places where local voices should be heard.
