

This is to note that on April 24, 2000, Mimi Dawson of this firm, Rachel Reinhardt and Jeff Ross of Time Domain Corporation, Scott Harris of Harris, Wiltshire and Grannis LLP and I met with Dale Hatfield, Chief of the Office of Engineering and Technology and his staff including Julius Knapp, Lisa Gaisford, Karen Rackley, John Reed, and Rodney Conway. We urged that Commission consideration of a notice of proposed rule making on ultra-wideband not be postponed until after WRC-2000. We also urged once more that any such NPRM clearly be open to input on technical issues relating to ultra-wideband including operating spectrum, constraints on operation, and techniques to avoid interference.
