**RE: Notice of Ex Parte Presentation on MM Docket No. 99-25**

Dear Ms. Salas:

I met with Roy Stewart, Linda Blair, Susanna Zwerling, Jim Bradshaw, Brian Butler, Jane Mago, Lisa Fowlkes, and Mary Beth Murphy on May 11, 2000.

The purpose of this meeting was for me to gain detailed information about the various procedures available to mediate interference complaints at the Commission, in particular with respect to complaints regarding the new low power radio service. Ms. Mago discussed procedures in the Enforcement Bureau. Members of the Mass Media Bureau staff described the current practice within the Bureau, in particular with respect to translators.

In addition, we discussed whether these procedures required any adjustment to adequately meet either the needs of complainants or licensees accused of causing interference. I expressed concern that low power radio licensees may be unable to shoulder a significant financial and legal burdens in a formal dispute process.

In an abundance of caution, I am filing this letter in accordance with section 1.1206(2) of the Commission's rules. This letter is being filed electronically today.
