This is to note that on June 16, 2000, Rachel Reinhardt and William Beeler of Time Domain Corporation and Phillip Inglis, with whom Time Domain has consulted, and I met with Mike Marcus, Julius Knapp, and John Reed of the Office of Engineering and Technology to discuss the measurement aspects of the ultra-wideband proceeding.
