

The attached e-mail message from Joseph D'Alessandro, a constituent of mine, has a concern with the FCC's eligibility rules for LPFM licenses. Mr. D'Alessandro states that individuals not belonging to an organization cannot apply for an LPFM license. My Staff Assistant, William Johnson, spoke with Mr. Klitzman from the FCC, who confirmed the rule that only organizations and individuals representing organizations can apply. I appreciate the information, however, for my constituent, it would be helpful if the FCC can forward any written information regarding the rationale behind this ruling, so that my constituent, Mr. D'Alessandro understands that the FCC is not infringing upon his constitutional rights.
