Comments

Reference is made to the Informal Request for Action filed jointly by Kenneth W. Bowles; Midwest Christian Media, Inc. (MCM); Flat Foot Media, Inc.; and Believers Bible Fellowship (Paul Hipps), dated July 19, 2000. The document requests that the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) process all the Low Power FM (LPFM) applications for construction permit filed in the August and November 2000 and future windows for the St. Louis Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA), at the same time in order to avoid giving preference to applicants from the State of Illinois over applicants from the State of Missouri or visa versa.

The LPFM radio steering committee of Grace Bible Chapel supports the Informal Request for Action.

Grace Bible Chapel (GBC) is a church that meets the qualifications of those imposed on LPFM licensees. It the intention of GBC to apply for a LPFM radio station construction permit during the November 2000 window. Such a station would complement our educational mission. Dr. Bowles and MCM are assisting us in the process of applying for such a station.

The chapel's property is on the Missouri side of the St. Louis MSA at 855 Gregory Lane, Fenton, Missouri. Our application may request this site as the location of a LPFM station. The site is approximately 15.2 km. from the nearest part of Illinois. Since the required co-channel separation between LP100 stations is 24 km., our proposed station could be excluded from the application process if the FCC processes Illinois applications for the St. Louis MSA before those from Missouri.

These comments will be filed on September 12, 2000, via the Commission's Electronic Comment Filing System. In addition the original and four copies will be supplied to the Commission on the same date via Airborne Express under its Airbill number 7464984170. Copies were also provided Drs. Bowles and Hipps for themselves and their organizations.
